15th September 2019

Can Christians be cultural? In this session we will be dipping into **Dan Strange's book, 'Plugged in.'**

20th October 2019

Is the Bible really God's word? In this session we will be considering God's word as God's word, and what that means for us, as we approach the Bible.

17th November 2019

In this session we will be considering **Relationships**, and how we think about them in the context of Christian living.

15th December 2019

Is the Bible one story, or lots of different stories? In this session we will be considering the unity of the Bible, how the Bible tells one story. Tracing through a Biblical theme from Genesis to Revelation.

19th January 2020

Can I be right with God? Knowing that we are right forgiven and right before God, brings great peace to us. But can we be right with God? Come and consider what the Bible says, and how people have interpreted this.

16th February 2020

How should I read my Bible? In this session, we will be considering how we can read our Bibles for ourselves intelligibly.

15th March 2020

Relationships. Here we will be revisiting the topic of how to conduct Christian relationships.

19th April 2020

Who is Jesus? Christians believe that Jesus is Lord. In this session we will be considering who Jesus is, and who he claimed to be.

17th May 2020

Is God simply the sum of his Parts? The 12 commandments, the basis of Christian ethics, begins by saying that God is One. But what does that mean, and why is it so important?
